

## Patrol Flag Rules for Final Bigfoot Camporee 2010

1. **Each Patrol is responsible for bringing up the materials they want to use to create their Patrol Flag at Camporee.** Anything you want to put on your Flag needs to be run through at Camporee or OA before the ultimate creation, but you are able to pre-plan.
2. This Flag does not have to become the new Patrol Flag, but could be an alternative.
3. **No more than 20 minutes work on Flag can be done before contest.** This does not include planning, but actual work on the Flag. Working on the Flag before coming up is optional.
4. OA is not allowed to tell you what is required to put on your Flag, but will tell you if you can't put something on it.
5. Please be able to use at least half of the station time on Patrol Flags. If too much time was used to work on Flag before Camporee, points will be deducted in the contest.

### Judging

We can't give too much away because we need this to be a contest with as clear results as possible. The Order of the Arrow and possibly some of the Camporee Staff will be the judges for the Patrol Flags. High score is out of 100 points in honor of the Centennial. Again, you are allowed to preplan, but can't do a lot of work before Camporee and the supplies are all up to the Patrols.

Things we will look for that we can tell you:

- Cooperation and teamwork among Patrols.
- Fleur-des-leis (Scout Symbol).
- Creativity
- Edges of the Flags (straight, wild and threads all over the place, etc.).
- If you brought a pole for it and can hook it on without problems.
- We will ask for a Patrol Yell and to see some more of your Scout Spirit.
- Sewing/stitching is optional, but does make the Flag nicer and seem like hard work was put into it, but **SCOUTS** have to be the ones to do it, not the Adults. Adults can demonstrate a little, but Scouts have to do the main work.

### Award

*The award besides more points is a new American Flag for the Troop or Patrol.*
